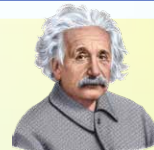

ADMISSION PROCESS

Admission process is purely driven on first come first served basis. To apply for admission, use the prescribed form, which will be issued along with the school prospectus worth Rs. 200. Interested students to get admission at Premier Senior Secondary School, Lala can obtain the prospectus from the school office on any working day. An admission committee, comprising teachers from various departments will oversee the process including student-counselling.

INFORMATION

1. Courses offered :

The institution offers HS Courses in all the three streams –Viz., Arts, Science and Commerce as per the rules and regulations of ASSEB-Division II. Admission is open for students of Class VI onwards as per the rules of ASSEB.

2. Syllabus :

As provided by the Assam State School Education Board (ASSEB) Division I & II.

3. Attendance & Internal Assessment :

A student must attend minimum 75% classes in each subject, appear in all weekly tests and submit all assignments, etc. Any student failing to fulfil above criterion shall not be allowed to sit in the examination conducted by SEBA and AHSEC.

4. Library Facilities :

Library-cum reading room facilities are available to encourage group studies among the students round the clock in presence of teachers.

5. Laboratories :

To provide in depth knowledge on wide ranging theories and concepts of science, we are developing well-equipped laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Computer Science. Special care is taken to encourage innovativeness among students to carry out projects related to their curriculum.

6. Smart Classroom :

To understand anything, visual effect is very important. So, we have introduced smart classroom.

7. Co-curricular Activities :

Co-curricular activities such as sports, quiz, seminar, group discussion, debate competition, students' parliament, extempore speech, etc. will be conducted regularly on every Saturday.

8. Fee Relaxation :

- (a) Students secured 90% and above marks will not have to pay any fee except the council registration fee and final examination fee.
- (b) Free admission for Distinction holders in the HSLC Examination.
- (c) Students scoring above 75% in the HSLC examination will be given 50% relaxation in all courses in admission fee.



9. Examination :

The Institution follows the Academic Calendar of ASSEB Division I & II in conducting classes, Unit Test, Annual Examination and other academic matter for secondary and senior secondary students. In addition, Weekly Class Test is conducted in each class on specific week days (Friday) and the performances of students are communicated through Notice Board and WhatsApp of parents/guardians.

10. Rajmohan Nath Scholarship :

This scholarship has been initiated in memory of Late Rajmohan Nath, an eminent scholar and archaeologist and a great son of our Barak Valley. The scholarship will be awarded to three meritorious students from BPL families.

11. School Infrastructure :

The school is located at S.S. Sarani, Lala, Ward No. 9. All classrooms are well furnished, adequate facility for toilet, drinking water, and canteen within the campus.

12. Discipline :

Students found in any sort of activities inside or outside the campus of the school that may impair good reputation of the institution, will be strictly dealt with by the disciplinary committee headed by the Principal. Using of mobile phone, chewing pan masala or guthka is strictly prohibited inside the campus.

13. Educational Excursion :

STUDENTS

- a) The school starts at 9:30 a.m. No student will be allowed to enter the class after 9:30 a.m.
- b) Morning assembly starts at 9:30 a.m. and all students must attend the assembly.
- c) Staying away from class is not considered except for serious reasons such as sudden illness or unforeseen circumstances.
- d) No leave of absence is given without previous written application from the guardian stating the reason.
- e) The student who remains absent from class shall attend class only after his/her absence gets considered by the Principal in the absence record.
- f) The belongings of the students such as books, pens, etc. will be under their own custody and responsibility.
- g) The student will have to purchase the uniform and text books as prescribed by the school authority.
- h) No student is allowed to attend the school without proper school uniform.
- i) No student is allowed to go outside of the school campus during the school hours (9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.)
- j) The students should be regular, sincere, and punctual in performing their duties.



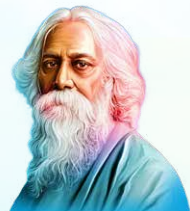

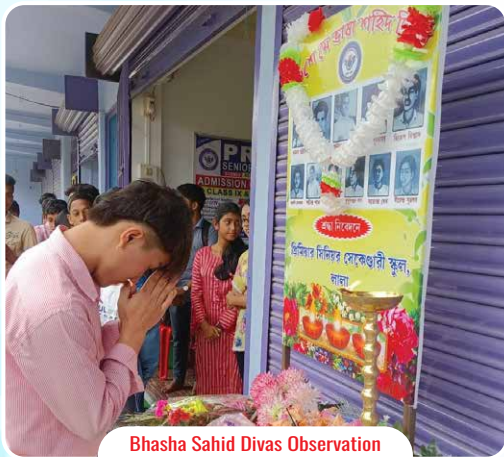

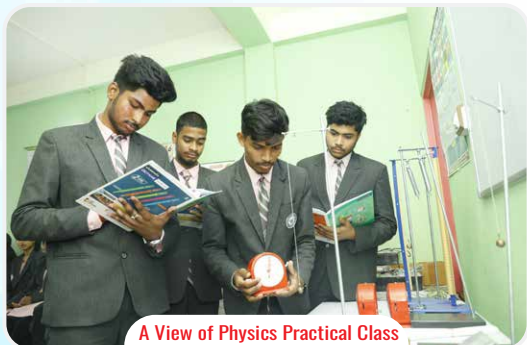
